In addition to having the fourth best score out of all participants (Ryan Donovan's 87), the MHS team finished in second place for aggregate team score.

Malden High School defeated Somerville at Unicorn GC in Stoneham, MHS' home course 44-28 for its 3rd win of the season. Matteo Pocobene, Ryan Donovan, Nick Wofsey, Andrew Delacey, Stephen Lucey and Jason Knox all won their matches convincingly.
